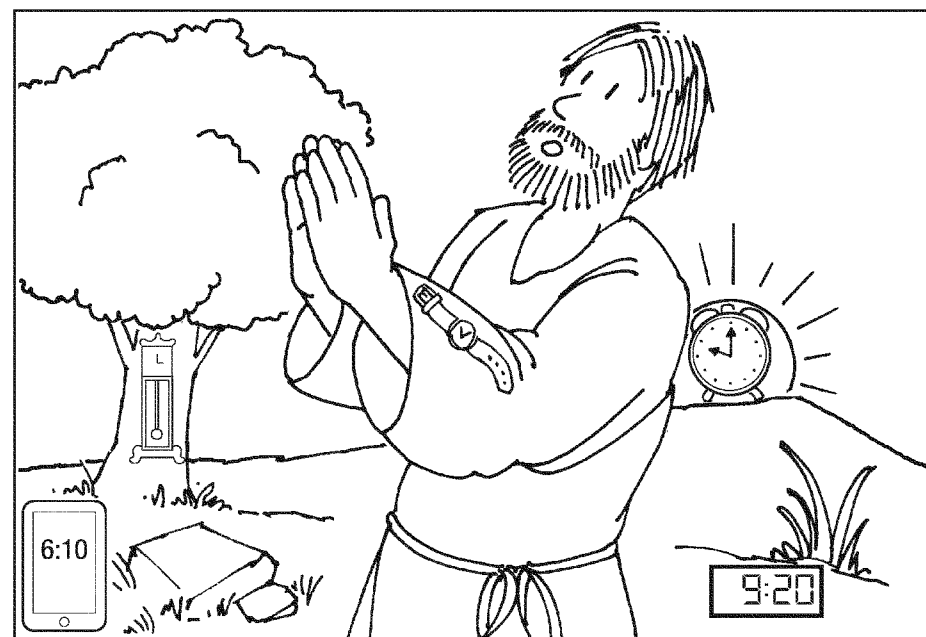
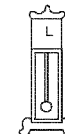
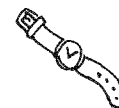
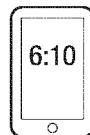
Jesus Prays

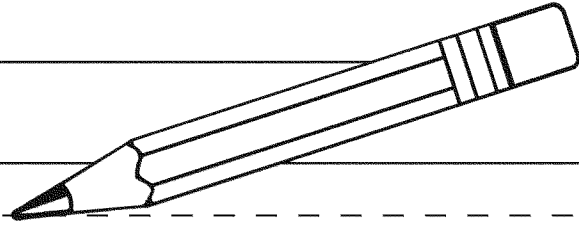
