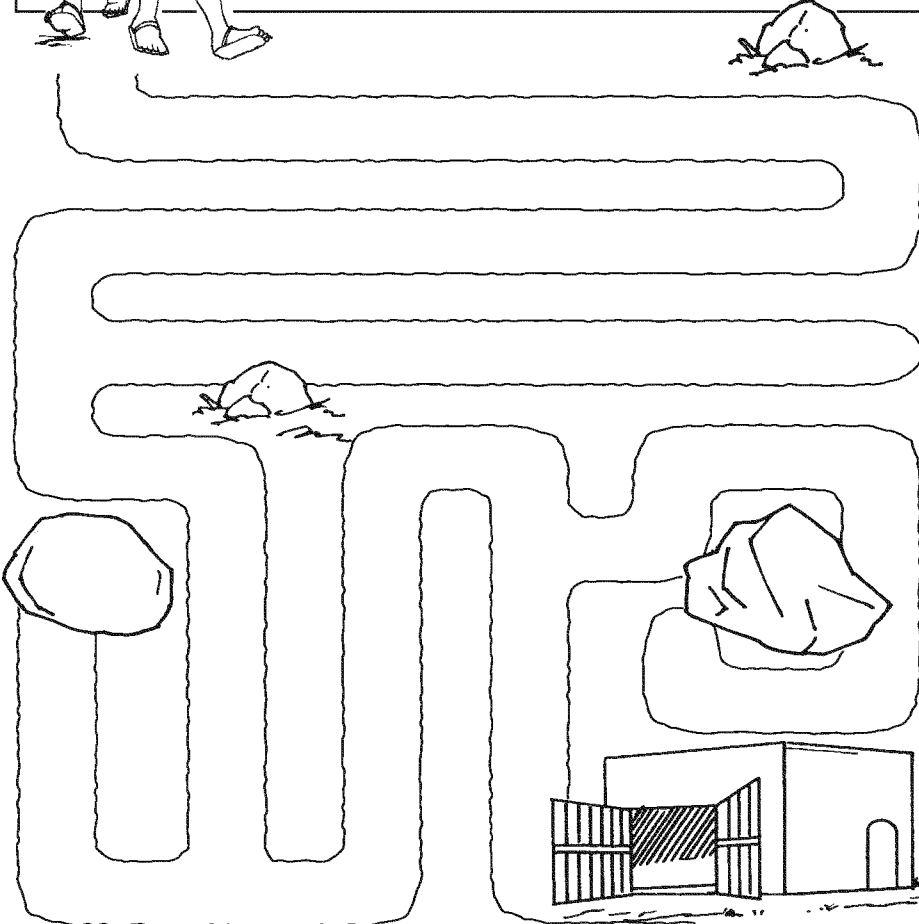


The owner of the field said,

wheat to the barn.

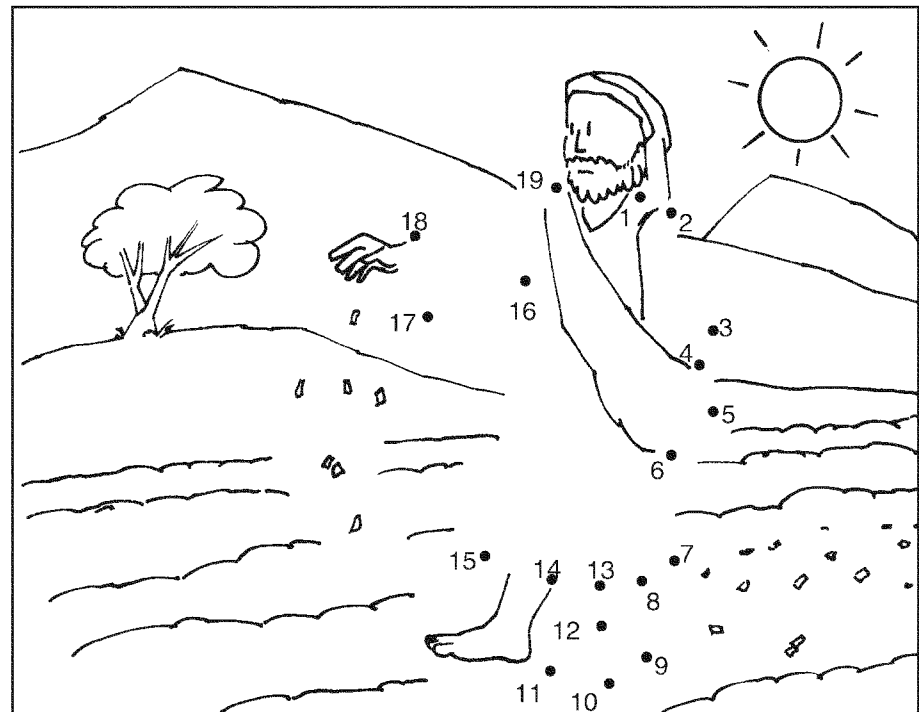


Jesus explained, “The field is the world,

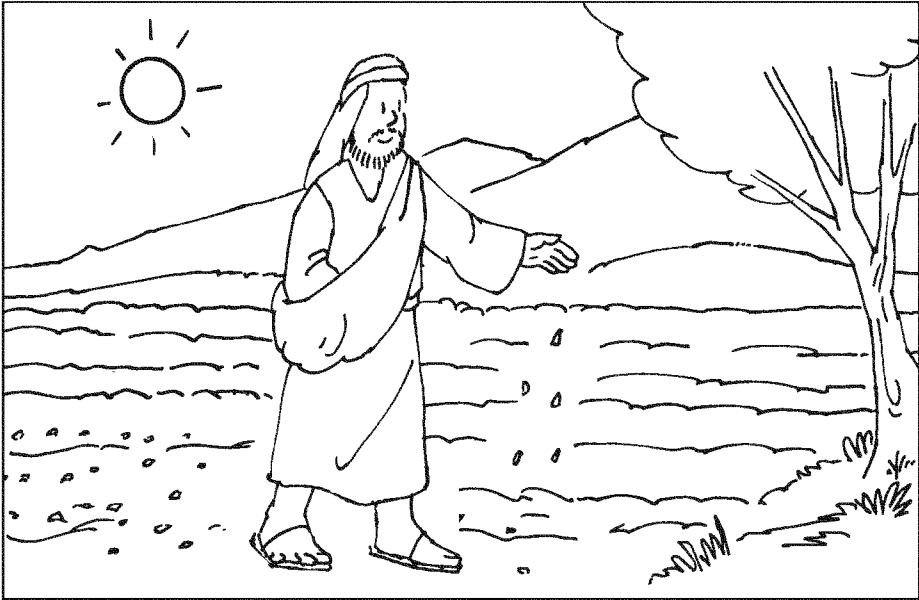
